Alice P. Allen Scholarship
2017 – 2018 Scholarship Information

The Alice P. Allen National Scholarship is named in honor of Iota's second National President (1946-1950). This \$2,000 scholarship is a one-time award for a **teenage mother** desiring to further her education beyond high school. Judging criteria will include academic performance/achievement, demonstrated leadership, and financial need.

1. Each candidate must be a graduating high school senior and a teenage mother transitioning to college
2. Each candidate must pursue a degree in a business related field of study
3. Each candidate must be planning to attend a post secondary accredited institution
4. Each candidate must submit the completed application packet to Gamma Mu Chapter on or before **January 15, 2018**. The application packet must include the following:
 - a. Completed Student Application Forms
 - b. Scholarship Registration Form (signed)
 - c. A current official/certified academic transcript with SAT or ACT scores
 - d. Two letters of recommendations
 - e. A 300-500 work autobiographical essay that includes career aspirations, leadership experience and significant achievements.
 - f. Family Income documentation (Recent copy of W2 Form and/or IRS 1040)
5. A committee of non-partisan judges will judge all essays. All decisions of the judges are final
6. The scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment before funds are allocated.

Essay Guidelines:

- Compose an autobiographical essay based on your career aspirations, most significant leadership experiences, and your most recent achievements
- Double-spaced typewritten pages (about 300-500 words)
- Submit your essay on 8 ½ x 11 inch white bond paper (one original and three copies)
- Mail all required Scholarship documentation and essays to:
